

Dear Parents,

National Public School Chikkabanavara has formulated certain guidelines keeping in mind the objectives and policies of the school, in order to have a safe learning environment.

The school has no-tolerance policy towards anything which compromises the safety of the students. We always consider parents as equal stake holders with equal responsibilities in order to ensure smooth governance of the system.

We are sure you would like to have a report on the Security measures being implemented by us at school as students safety is of utmost importance, and all priority will be given to ensure the same.

Students will not be allowed to switch bus routes or take their own transport without prior permission from the school.

- Parents are asked to pick up and drop the kids in a definite place and time.
- 1 set of I D card have been issued to the students, which should be worn to the school on a regular basis.
- Parent/guardian/driver appointed to collect the student from the school should produce the parent ID card
- Parents are asked to notify the school during the change of transport routes.
- Parents of students not using the Transport facility are informed to make necessary arrangements for the same and brief them about the security measures.
- The school is equipped with CCTV'S Surveillance at common areas, in and outside the school building.
- Fire-extinguishers are available on all floors
- We are constantly interacting with the Transport in-charge to educate and monitor the bus drivers and help staff with regard to the safety of the children.
- Visitors and parents are screened at the entrance and only allowed to enter after they have entered all details.
- A boundary has been well defined beyond which no one will be allowed to pass (unless accompanied by a member of the school).
- All maintenance and building work related issues are conducted after school hours.
- We have deputed in charge teacher in each floor for maintaining discipline and movement of children during school hours including the break time.

- A security squad (comprises of 4 teachers and 2 non teaching staff) has been put in place to walk around the school in their respective free periods, and report any issue of concern.
- A regular monthly meeting is conducted by the Principal with the attenders, housekeeping staffs, bus drivers and security personals.

In the school campus teachers are cautious and monitor the movement of the students during breaks and dispersal.

- Young kids are escorted by their lady bus assistants and assigned teachers to their respective bus routes.
- A team of teachers have been appointed to oversee the measures of security.
- During outdoor activity a responsible and trained staff will be assigned to accompany the students
- We have no-tolerance policy towards corporal punishments.
- Sensitising the teaching and non-teaching staff is a continuous process.
- Class Teachers or Subject Teachers will accompany students to Yoga, Swimming, Music classes and to other Activities.

Teachers are trained for adolescent related issues

As per CBSE curriculum Adolescent Education Programmes for 6-10 have been initiated where topics like gender equality, gender sensitivity have been conducted through activities and seminars.

Primary children have been instructed about the safe keeping habits of good touch and bad touch.

Professional Nurse who is fully equipped and trained for first-aid facility is available.

Our teachers are trying their best to see that no child is left unattended in the class or during the short and long breaks of the school hours. We also seek your constant support and cooperation for the safety of ALL THE STUDENTS who are under our care during the school hours.
